JOB DESCRIPTION FOR THE POSITION OF MOBILE INFANT CO TEACHER

Summary The Mobile Infant Co-Teacher is responsible for the care and education of infants age 12-24 months. The Co-Teacher is responsible for creating a warm and nurturing relationship with each child and family. Using observation and assessment tools, the Mobile Infant Co-Teacher documents each child's growth and learning in relation to his or her developmental level and the Vermont Early Learning Standards to design an age-appropriate curriculum that supports communication, social skills, and autonomy through exploration and play. The Mobile Infant Co-Teacher reports to the center Director and Assistant Director.

Job Responsibilities

- Maintain an open, friendly, and cooperative relationship with each child and family to promote a strong home-school connection.
- Initiate daily classroom activities to promote exploration through physical, emotional, cognitive and linguistic domains (e.g. sing-a-longs, art projects, sensory exploration, and outdoor gross motor stimulation).
- Respond to the children through appropriate touching, holding, smiling and speaking in a positive tone of voice to convey acceptance and positive self-worth.
- Provide daily care individually to each infant, including but not limited to diapering every 2 hours and feeding on demand, and documenting individual daily needs, reports.
- Supervise infants in all areas of the classroom or outdoor environment.
- Inspect the school site and equipment for potential safety hazards; taking corrective action or informing the Director to prevent injuries
- Comply with all Vermont Child Care Licensing Regulations and Annette's Preschool Employee and Policy Handbooks.

Preferred Experience and Qualifications

- B.A. in Early Education or CDA minimum.
- Two years (+) experience working with children, and implementing developmentally appropriate curriculum for infant (age 12-24 months) in home or center based settings.
- Experience observing and assessing children (ages 12-24 months).
- CPR/First Aid training very helpful.

Required Skills and Abilities

- Display a genuine disposition for engaging infants and promoting curiosity and learning.
- Knowledge of the VT Early Learning Standards.
- Be able to work both independently and cooperatively with other staff members.
- Be professional, punctual and prepared.

Work Environment and Expectations

Through age appropriate programming, Annette's serves children age 6 weeks to 12 years.
